

Stash Killer Afghan

A Great way to use up odds and ends, novelty yarns, ribbons, and that stuff you bought on sale but can't remember why....

Grab about 3000yds of various color coordinated yarns - a couple of these should be ones you can carry throughout and about worsted weight (roughly 500yds). With #35 needles and at least 6 strands of yarn, CO 45-50 stitches. The gauge varies but seems to run about a stitch an inch so 45 stitches will get you about 45". Knit 6 rows and then continue in stockinette stitch with a 5 st. garter border on each side. When you are satisfied with the length, knit 6 rows garter and BO. Change yarns as the impulse strikes, but not more than two in the same row. I actually used up to 8 yarns at a time in this one, cause a few were quite thin.
